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Pass through the A30 booths in one tap!

The A30 Express announces that, in addition to installing contactless payment devices, its booths accept debit card payment. After a trial period on a few stations at the beginning of the year, lanes are now more easily and rapidly accessible with electronic payment.

Always on the lookout for solutions to simplify its users' passage and prevent slow-downs at the tollbooth, the A30 has taken steps to replace its payment stations at the end of 2019.

It is therefore no longer necessary to insert one's card, users simply need to wave it in front of the dedicated space. The contactless system is functional with both debit and credit cards.

Electronic payment only

For the safety of its attendants and Highway 30 users during this pandemic, payments at the tollbooth can only be made through electronic methods, until further notice. Drivers are therefore invited to prepare their debit or credit card to proceed with contactless payment.

The transponder, however, remains the best way to pass through the tollbooth with a shorter wait time. It is possible to acquire one online on the website www.a30express.com/en. Moreover, the transponder saves its owner \$0.10 at every passage.

The A30 Express wishes to thank its users for their collaboration and invite them to take out their debit card at their next passage through the A30 tollbooth.
